- All registered participants in the tournament will be required to wear a life jacket in the boat any time the combustion engine is running.
- All registered participants will be required to adhere to all governmental safety regulations, Coast Guard Safety Rules, Fishing Rules of the State of Missouri and all rules of normal angling etiquette.
- All registered participants in the tournament are required to sign a liability release form.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated; any discrepancies will be decided by the Tournament Committee.
